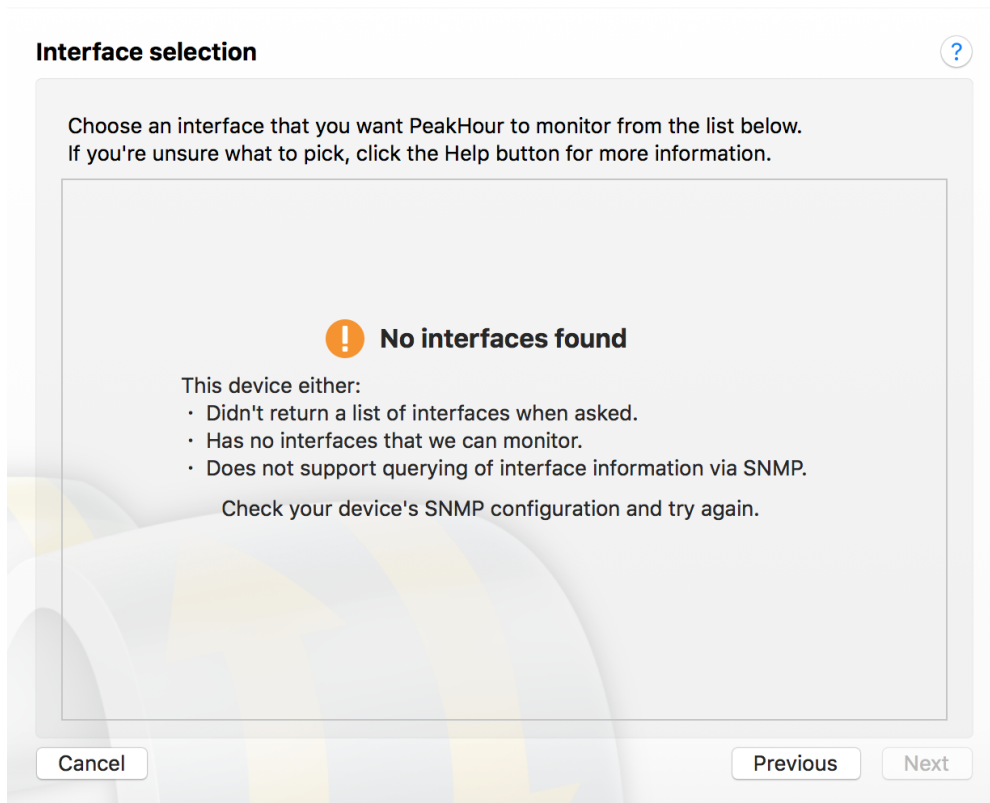


# "No Interfaces Found" when choosing an interface

When attempting to add a target using SNMP, you get the following error on the **Interface selection** screen:



## What does this error mean?

The most often reason for getting this error is inadequate permissions with the SNMP device you're talking to.

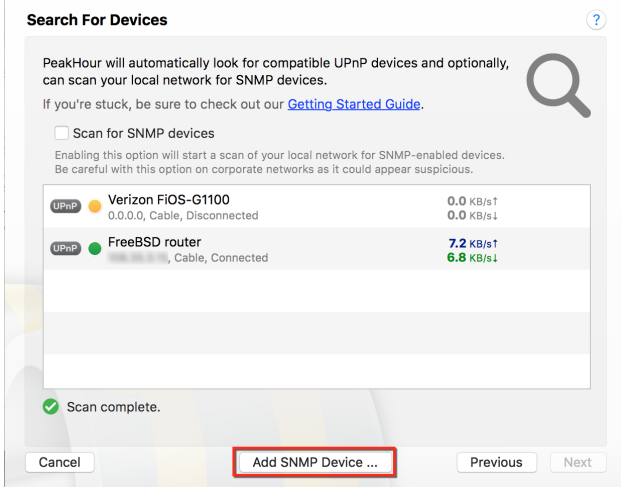
Some reasons for this include:

- You enabled SNMP on your Mac using [PeakHour Enabler](#) but you didn't enable the "From other computers" checkbox
- You're using an incorrect SNMP community.

## How can I fix it?

Some steps you can take to try to fix it:

1. If you used the **Scan for SNMP devices** checkbox, try using the **Add SNMP Device...** button and add the details manually.



- 2. Make sure you are entering the correct SNMP community / password.
- 3. If you used **PeakHour Enabler** and didn't check the **From other computers** checkbox, make sure you are clicking **Add SNMP Device...** and are specifying 'localhost' as the hostname.

If this doesn't work, run PeakHour Enabler again, enable the **From other computers** checkbox and try again.
