

# Connection Quality Monitor

The Target tab mainly provides a summary of the currently selected target, showing you information about its SNMP or UPnP configuration.

<b>Description</b>	This field lets you configure a description or name for this target. The description is used throughout PeakHour to refer to the target, so it's recommended that you set something that is meaningful to you.
<b>Enabled</b>	Determines if this Target is enabled (visible) or disabled (hidden).
<b>Hide if unreachable</b>	If the device can't be found or is unreachable, hide it from the main view and (if enabled) the menu bar.
<b>Status</b>	The status of this Target.
<b>Monitoring</b>	A description of what this Target is monitoring.
<b>Edit in Configuration Assistant</b>	Click this button to edit the Target's configuration. See <a href="#">Configuration Assistant</a> for more information.
